Bus Lanes

Following trials, Transport for London is allowing motorcycles to use some bus lanes in London. Most are in the West End, but this will also apply to part of the Harrow Road. Please take extra care crossing main roads; motorcycles can be hard to spot and if you're not expecting to see them in a bus lane that you usually cross then they are even more 'invisible.' It may also be that motorcyclists assume the new regulations apply to all bus lanes and there will be motorcycles in bus lanes that they should not be in.

I'd also like to take this opportunity to remind all parents to be very careful crossing the Marylebone Road; this is one of the busiest roads in Europe.
