#### Welcome Back

#### School Lunches

During the summer holiday the Local Authority, Westminster, increased the cost of school lunches. This is now £1.85 per day, an increase of 5p. This works out at £9.25 per week and £68.45 for this Term (4th September to 26th October). Please note that children should not swap from school lunch to a packed lunch, or vice versa, during a

school Term. If you do want to change, please do this at the end of the Term to start in the following Term.

#### More Reminders

- The school day starts at 9.00am. All children should be in the playground just before 9 o'clock. Children should stay with the adult who brought them to school until they are passed into the care of the class teacher. Obviously this does not apply to older children who come to school on their own!
- Outside Toilets. Please

- Mobile 'Phones. Just a reminder that we do not allow children to bring mobile 'phones to school except in exceptional circumstances. If you believe this applies to your child talk to a member of the office staff.
- Toys and electronic games/ devices (such as mp3 players) are not allowed in school.
- School Uniform. We are still in Summer uniform at the moment: white polo shirts, grey trousers (or mid-blue gingham check dresses for the girls) and school sweatshirts. Please remember that trainers are not allowed. It's hard to tell what is and what is not a trainer these days the manufacturers are making shoes that look like trainers and plain trainers that look

- more like shoes. As a simple guide, if it's plain black with no eye-catching logo it's a shoe, if it's branded with the obvious logo of a company best known for making trainers it's a trainer! This probably isn't very helpful ....!
- Holidays. There is a holiday list on our school website (address at the top of page 1) and there's a small, wallet sized card with this newsletter that lists our holiday dates for you to keep handy. We do not authorise any holiday that falls outside of our normal dates, so please book flights well ahead and keep them within school holidays. Our attendance for last school year was 95.6%, which is higher than the Westminster average and higher than national averages. Thank you!
