Since last term, when a survey of parents showed that an over-whelming majority of our families would make use of an online payment system, we have been busy working to make this happen.

We have had a trial of a system called 'SchoolComms' and have now committed to buying this in for next year.

In order to install all of the software, we need to upgrade our school server, and this is in progress.

Hopefully, all of the hardware will be in place before the Christmas holiday. Ideally, we would like all of the software installed before the holiday too, so that we can use the payment gateway at the start of the January Term, but I think this may be a little ambitious.
