Tests and Assessments

This time of the year is always a busy time in school with testing (Year 6 SATs tests, Year 1 Phonic Check) and assessing where the children are in their learning. This information will be on your child's end of year school report in three weeks time.

Year 1 are given a 'Phonics Check' at this time of the year and Year 2 have a follow-up check. This year 56% of the children in Year 1 scored enough marks to be considered at the 'expected standard' in their phonics. This may not sound very high, but it is in line with the National percentages for last year (this year's national figures are not yet available). All but one of the Year

2 children reached the 'expected standard' in their follow-up check.
