Remembrance Day

Every year we mark the two minutes silence at 11 o'clock as part of our Remembrance Day observation. This

year we will also be having a short, simple commemoration at the front of the school to mark the return of the war memorial plaques to the parish. The two memorial plaques were fixed on the school wall facing Enford Street towards the end of last year.



They were removed from the Parish Church 13 years ago as part of the church refurbishment and were in storage in Yorkshire. We felt it was right to return them to the parish - especially as 2014 marks the 100th anniversary of the outbreak of The Great War.

26 of the names on the memorial plaques are of people who went to St Mary's Bryanston Square School. In those days it would have been an 'all-through' school, not just a Primary School.
