School Journey

Good luck to our Year 6 class who are off to Marchant's Hill this morning on School Journey. Marchant's Hill is near Hindhurst in Surrey - an 'Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty' and the children always have a great time. They do a lot of 'Outdoor and Adventurous' sport in a secure and safe environment and it's a great way to develop the children's confidence, independence and cooperative skills.

Year 6 SATs

Our provisional Year 6 SATs results for 2012/13 are as we expected. This was a small class (23 pupils who count towards our figures, excluding one pupil who was new to Year 6 in the Spring Term and had no English) which means that each pupil counts as more than 4%. The class also had large numbers of children with Special Educational Needs (8 out of 23 pupils: 1 child with a statement, 4 recorded as 'school action plus' and 3 at 'school action.'

Despite this we attained:

• 87% at Level 4 or more in Reading

- 78.3% in Writing and
- 83% in maths.

The provisional government figures also indicate that the children made **13.7 points progress**, as an average, from Year 2 to the end of Year 6. The expectation is that they will make 12 points progress.

These figures are all provisional at the moment.
