

### **Building Works**

Hopefully you have all received the letter from Jon Ward, Chair of Governors, about the building works taking place next to the school. We are in constant contact with the contractors, and the following safeguards are in place:

- Windows overlooking the playground from the temporary offices will be obscured
- The entire structure of the site will be fully enclosed with acoustic screening to minimise dust and noise
- The method by which the foundations are put in will be less percussive and therefore less disruptive
- The rear fence is to be reinforced/supported
- Triple glazed windows have been fitted to the Year 4 classroom to cut out noise
- They have agreed to refrain from using heavy machinery close to the school boundary during playtimes
