#### **Maths Mastery**

In November, we hosted visitors from Shanghai who came to look at our approach to teaching Maths. We use an approach called 'Maths Mastery', used in Singapore and China, which helps the children to understand mathematical concepts in great depth.

This term we have developed a new link with Wetherby Preparatory School in Bryanston Square. We started by visiting their Science Labs, where their Science teachers showed Y5 how to do a heart dissection.

Next term we will be joining them for English and Classics events, too.



# **Music Developments**

We have begun to work with London Music Masters this year for the first time. Children in Reception (F2) have a fortnightly musicianship lesson, and next year they will all start to learn the violin! Other classes are also starting to benefit; Year 5 had a Singing Workshop led by professional musicians and LMM will be offering staff training in delivering classroom Music over the course of the year.
